

ST: How do you feel after winning the 2020 Global Clean environment awards?

ST: According to you what is the biggest environmental threat in the world at present?

Jennifer: The biggest environmental threat in the world right now is the amount of, trash waste and toxins our human is putting into our air, water and land. The amount of carbon dioxide levels in the atmosphere have increased "from 280 parts per million to 400 parts per million in the last 150 years. Causes cited were the burning of fossil fuels, intensive agriculture and other human activities, according to NASA. Besides, 9 million tons of plastic sintering to our ocean every year, according to The Global Risks Report. The report points out that plastic pollution is so great in 2018 already that micro-plastics is found in 83% of tap-water in the world. Chemical pollution from agriculture and industries is another problem where plants and animals are killed or are affected by toxins.

ST: What do you think a common person can do to help the environment?

Jennifer: Yes, YOU and I can make a big difference and can help protect this planet we call Earth. First of all is stop littering. when we go hiking or go to the beach please do not leave trash, packagings or plastic bottles behind. We can also help clean up the area by picking up trash, fishing lines and plastic bottles that we see. Also it is good to reduce or eliminate the use of plastic bags and plastic bottles. I encourage you to use a water
